FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Communication – Please communicate concerns directly with the adult involved in a situation. If you are unable to resolve your concerns with the adult (teacher, para or staff), the next step is to contact the principal. If you are unable to resolve your concern with the principal, the next step is to contact our

superintendent, followed by the school board. We believe most conflicts can be resolved by talking to the person directly involved.

Specialist Schedule - The District has informed me that we will be moving forward as planned with the 6-day schedule the week of MEA (Oct. 18). We are currently on a 6 week schedule. We have many safety measures that are in place: Ventilation systems, HEPA filter air systems, hand hygiene, maintaining 6 feet or more of distancing between adults and students, and universal masking (to name a few). Additionally, all staff have had an opportunity to be vaccinated. Please mark this down on your calendar so you can plan accordingly for your child's specials.

Birthday Parties – We ask that you please avoid asking teachers to send out invitations at school to birthday parties. Students also need to go home after school and then be transported to the party. We appreciate your help in this area so we can avoid creating the feeling of being left out on the part of other students.

Thank You to our Volunteers – It has been so helpful to have our parent volunteers back again this year. We missed you last year! Thank you for the support you have provided to our teachers and students.
