Item Drop off Procedures –

- **Deephaven** – Please call our main number at 952-401-6900 to let us know that you are dropping off an item for your child. The items needs to be left in the vestibule. Staff will get the item to your child.
- **MHS** – The west office is the being used as the 4th and 5th grade office. Park and walk into the office. Drop off the item with the secretary along with your child’s name and room number.

Early Student Pickup -

- **Deephaven** - When you arrive to pickup your child early, please call the main office at 952-401-6900 to let us know that you are here, and we will call your child down to the front door. **Please do not enter the office.** Please sign your child out on the clipboard on the table in the vestibule and remain there until your child comes out to you.
- **MHS Office** – You will also use the west office if you are picking your child up early. **The phone number is 952-401-4054.** Keep in mind that it takes an average of 8-10 minutes for your child to walk from the classroom to the west office. When taking your child to an appointment, keep in mind the extra time it will take picking them up at MHS.
